

Oh My Green, Inc. Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes how OMG collects, uses and protects information.

- We'll refer to this Privacy Policy as the "Privacy Policy"; to our website (through which we deliver some of our Services) as the "Site"; and to our software application designed to interface with our Site as our "App".
- We'll refer to all the services we provide (including the Site, the App, and other health, fitness and nutrition services), individually and collectively, as the "Services".
- We'll refer to Oh My Green as "OMG" or "we" or "us" or "our".
- We'll refer to you, the person or entity accessing our Site, as "you" or "your".

Your privacy is really important to Oh My Green.

Protecting your privacy is really important to us. With this in mind, we're providing this Privacy Policy to explain our practices regarding the collection, use, disclosure and protection of information that we receive through our Site and our Services. This Privacy Policy does not apply to any third-party websites, services or applications, even if they are accessible through our Site or our Services.

We collect two types of information.

All of the information and data we collect from you will be referred to collectively as "Your Information." Our primary goals in collecting information are to provide, and improve, our Site and our Services. We collect two different types of information from users of our Site.

First, we collect information that you provide to us. This includes any of your registration/account information (such as, for example, your name, email address, and/or other personally identifying or non-public information), as well as any other data that you may choose to submit, store, post, display or otherwise enter into our Site, including but not limited to information about you (such as picture, your address, your food preferences, etc.) and information you choose to provide about your company (such as inventory, product requests, equipment, etc.). Please note that if you decide not to provide us with the information we request, you may not be able to access all of the features of our Site or Services.

Second, we collect and aggregate information about the use of our Site and our Services ("Log Data"). Log Data could include information such as your Internet Protocol (IP) address, browser type, operating system, the web page that you were visiting before accessing our Site, the pages or features of our Site which you browsed and the time spent on those pages or features, search terms, the links on our Site that you clicked on and other statistics. We use Log Data to administer our Site and our Services, and we analyze (and may engage third parties to analyze) Log Data to improve, customize and enhance our Site and our Services by expanding their features and functionality and tailoring them to your (and other users') needs and preferences.

Our App; Location Information

If you access our Site using a mobile device, we may collect information such as a device identifier, user settings and the operating system of your device, as well as information about your use of our Services. When you use our App, we may collect and store information about your location by converting your IP address into a rough geo-location or by accessing your mobile device's GPS coordinates or coarse location if you enable location services on your device. We may use location information to improve and personalize our Services for you. If you do not want us to collect location information, you may disable that feature on your mobile device.

How We Use Your Information.

We will use Your Information, in compliance with this Privacy Policy, to help us deliver the Services to you. You agree that we may use Your Information (including store, record, transmit, maintain, use, reproduce, modify, adapt, and distribute it) to the extent necessary to carry out our obligations in providing the Site and the Services. In addition, you agree that we may use Your Information to help us improve the Site and the Services and make them better for all users of our Site and our Services. In particular, we may collect and analyze Your Information and other information relating to the provision, use and performance of various aspects of the Site and the Services and related systems and technologies. We may use such information and data to improve and enhance the Site and the Services and for other development, diagnostic and corrective purposes in connection with the Site and the Services, and disclose such data (solely in aggregate or other de-identified form) in connection with our business. We may also use Your Information to contact you.

How We Don't Use Your Information.

We will not sell, trade, rent or otherwise disclose Your Information except as described in this Privacy Policy.

We Work to Keep Your Information Secure.

We take reasonable administrative, physical and electronic measures designed to protect Your Information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. Please be aware, however, that no method of transmitting information over the Internet or storing information is completely secure. Accordingly, we cannot guarantee the absolute security of any information.

We May Disclose Your Information if the Law Requires It or to Protect OMG or Others.

We cooperate with government and law enforcement officials or private parties to enforce and comply with the law. We may disclose Your Information to government or law enforcement officials or private parties as we, in our sole discretion, believe necessary or appropriate: (i) to respond to claims, legal process (including subpoenas); (ii) to protect our property, rights and safety and the property, rights and safety of a third party or the public in general; and (iii) to stop any activity that we consider illegal, unethical or legally actionable activity.

You Can Modify or Delete Your Information.

You can access and modify Your Information by logging into your account. If you want us to delete Your Information and your account, please contact us at support@OhMyGreen.com with your request. We'll take steps to delete your information as soon we can, but some information may remain in archived/backup copies for our records or as otherwise required by law.

You Can Opt Out of Communications from Us.

We may periodically send you free newsletters and e-mails that directly promote our Services. When you receive such promotional communications from us, you will have the opportunity to "opt-out" (either through your account or by following the unsubscribe instructions provided in the e-mail you receive). There may be certain communications regarding the Services which you will not be able to opt out; for example, communications regarding updates to this Privacy Policy or our terms of service.

We Use Cookies on our Site.

Like many website owners and operators, we use “cookies” on the Site. Cookies are small text files that are placed on your hard drive by a Web server when you access our Site. We may use both session cookies and persistent cookies to identify that you’ve logged in to the Site and to tell us how and when you interact with our Site. We may also use cookies to monitor aggregate usage and web traffic routing on our Site and to customize and improve our Site and our Services. Unlike persistent cookies, session cookies are deleted when you log off from the Services and close your browser. Although most browsers automatically accept cookies, you can change your browser options to stop automatically accepting cookies or to prompt you before accepting cookies. Please note, however, that if you don’t accept cookies, you may not be able to access all portions or features of the Site or the Services.

Links to Other Sites

Our Site or Services may contain links to websites and services that are owned or operated by third parties (each, a “Third-Party Service”). Any information that you provide on or to a Third-Party Service or that is collected by a Third-Party Service is provided directly to the owner or operator of the Third-Party Service and is subject to that owner’s or operator’s privacy policy. We are not responsible for the content, privacy or security practices and policies of any Third-Party Service. To protect your information, we recommend that you carefully review the privacy policies of all Third-Party Services that you access.

California Residents’ Additional Rights

If you are a California resident, you may request and obtain from us, once a year, free of charge, a list of third parties, if any, to whom we have disclosed Your Information for direct marketing purposes during the preceding calendar year, and the categories of Your Information shared with those third parties.
